INFRASTRUCTURE THAT GUIDES BEAUFORT COUNTY *forward*

Since 1998, Beaufort County voters have approved 3 Transportation Sales Tax Referendums that have invested **over \$300 million** into our community's infrastructure. Projects have included:

- Widening of SC 170 to Four Lanes Across 13 miles
- New River Crossings to Improve Evacuation and Safety
- New US 278 Eastbound Hilton Head Bridge with Access to Pinckney Island
- Expansion of Bluffton Parkway
- Improvements to US 278 and US 17 Corridors
- Lady's Island Traffic Upgrades
- Sidewalk and Multi-use Pathway Investments

These projects have improved safety, reduced congestion, and helped support Beaufort County. A citizen-led Transportation Advisory Committee is now evaluating how to invest in our community and protect what matters most. But they need **your voice**.

2018 PENNY REFERENDUM: Transportation Project *Update*



100% Completion Goal by 2028

The program is committed to finishing all scheduled transportation projects by the end of 2028, with the exception of the US 278 Corridor Project, which will be complete by 2031.



Momentum is Growing

2 projects are currently under construction or were recently completed, paving the way for even more infrastructure improvements.



All Projects in ROW by 2026

By the end of 2026, all remaining projects in the program will have entered the Right of Way (ROW) acquisition phase.



2026 Construction Kickoffs

4 additional projects are scheduled to break ground and will begin construction in 2026.



- HILTON HEAD ISLAND BRIDGE SPANS -

The US 278 Corridor Project will replace aging bridge spans, improve safety, and ensure hurricane evacuation reliability. Construction is expected to begin in 2028, with bridge completion in 2031.
